The Motto of our Parent Institution is "Education for All". Since its inception, the college has been imparting quality higher education to the students from rural area, It is one of the most socio- economical educationally backward and drought prone areas in Beed District of Marathwada region. Agriculture is the prime occupation of people in the locality. The financial capacity and per capita income of the people is remarkable low. Irregular and less rain fall renders the masses to migrate to Sugar Factories in the western Maharashtra for Sugar Cain cutting.

It is a co-education multifacalty institution having student strenght of more than 1500 from various sections of society affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad (Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar) The College got permanent affiliation status in 2005, After the first cycle of assessment & accreditation by NAAC in 2004. It has been recognised under section 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act, 1956. It has also got ISO 9001:2015 certification. The college got accredited at 'B' Grade by NAAC in January 2019.

The college was started in a small, rented building wit 120 students only. Today, it has its own 10 acre campus, a three-storeyed building with well-furnished administrative office, separate buildings for the central library, gym khana, indoor games, wrestling, womens hostel, It also has vast play ground with 400 mtr. running-track, residential facilities for wrestlers, parking facility, compound wall, open-air auditorium, botanical garden, vermi-compost project, drip-irrigation, pure drinking water facility etc.

General Rules for Admission

- 1) Admission to XI Class will be given to the students who have passed the S.S.C. Examination from any divisional Board of Maharashtra Board of Secondary Education.
- 2) Students from the states other than Maharashtra seeaking admission to XI should apply for the eligibility certificate to the H.S.C. Board Aurangabad their admission will be finalized only after the sanction of Eligibility by the Board.
- Admission to B.A., B.Com., B.Sc. and B.C.A. First year shall be given to the students who have passed the H.S.C. Exam, from any division of the Maharashtra State Board or Secondary and Higher Secondary Education. Admissions are also open for students who belong to other states or Countries.
- 4) The Student who have passed D.T.Ed. (Diploma in Teachers Educating and Diploma in Polytechnic are also eligible for admission to B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., B.Sc. (Comp. Science) and B.Sc. (I.T.) first year.
- 5) The students must retain all the receipts of fees or dues obtained by them. The refund of the fees, deposits and other amounts shall not be paid unless the receipts are produced.
- 6) The prescribed fees and other charges must be paid at the time of admission.
- 7) The Students should take admission before prescribed date.
- 8) All necessary documents, certificates and undertakings should be submitted in original at the time of admission.
- 9) The Principal has the discretionary powers to make any change in the rules of admissions within the framework of norms laid down by the Govt. by Maharashtra.
- 10) Students will have to complete the procedure of admission every year for a new class. The admission will be for one academic year only.
- Thee Sutdents from the state of Maharashtra seeking admissions to B.A., B.Com, B.Sc., B.Sc. (Computer Science) & B.Sc. (I.T.) frist year should apply for the eligibility certificate to Dr. B.A.M.U. Aurangabad. Their admissions shall be finalized only after the issue of the eligibility certificate from the University.
- 12) The Subject selection and combination, offered once will remain final.

Code of Conduct for Students

- 1) Every Student's behavior must be disciplined while in the class-room or in the premises.
- 2) No outside influence- political or any other should be brought in the college directly or indirectly.

Infrastructure and Student

Support Services:

1) Administrative Block:

The Office is fully computerized. There are separate sections, windows for various services, seeking admission, filling forms of scholarship EBC, Free ship, getting leaving Certificate, bonafide, identity card, convection forms, paying fees by cash, attestation etc. services are made student friendly.

2) Grand Library (KRC):

Our library, Knows as Knowledge Resource Centre, is fully computerized with OPAC & INFLIBNET facilities it is enriched with text books, reference books, rare books, National and International Journals, Encyclopedia, Dictionaries, etc.

Every year, there is a purchase according to the demands of the staff and the students.

3) GYM Khana:

We provide all sports facilities of indoor & outdoor games, taking into consideration various tournaments. All modern equipment are made available in Gym, and special coaching is provided. Indoor games like Chess, Carrom and Table Tannis are played by students in free time. Yoga camp is organised every year on 21st June.

4) Vast Playground:

There is a vast playground having 400 mtr Running Track and various sports grounds as cricket, Kho-Kho, Volley Ball, Foot Ball, Kabaddi, Tennis & Badminton. Students practiced on ground every day. A special coaching camp is organised before ICT or IUT tournaments.

5) Womens Hostel:

A spacious women's hostel is available for the girls students. The intake of the hostle is 60 along with safety and security, the hostel provides an opportunity of higher education to the girls.

6) Ladies Commen Room:

For the girl Students and staff, a ladies common room is made available. Also a sanitory napkin vending machine is in oppression. Ladies from the staff and girls students can rest there in recess.

7) Laboratories:

All science laboratories are well equipped and updated. Every year, their is new purchase. Dead Stock and all records are maintained. Fire extinguisher is fixed in each laboratory. Students use masks and approns during practicals.

8) Computer Lab:

We have well - furnished computer lab. Students of B.Sc. (Computer Science) and B.Sc. (I.T.) Make optimum use of the lab, Also, every common student goes to the lab and is familiar with it.

9) Seminar Hall:

There is a spacious seminar hall, used for meetings, training, seminars, workshops etc.

10) Language Cum Soft Skills Laboratory:

It is mainly used for enhancement English language communication skills & Soft Skills of the Students.

11) National Service Scheme (NSS):

There is NSS Unit in the college. Special camps are organised in rural area where students are taught the valve of physical work, community service & personality development.

Extension activities, such as blood donation Camp, AIDS Awareness, Cleanliness drive, Water Conservation, & Tree Plantation are also undertaken by the volunteers.

12) Department of Life Long Learning & Extension:

The Department provides an opportunity to the students to undergo career guidance programme. The Unit consists of 50 students and Organizes guidance camps for students.

13) Blood Donation Camp:

Ahmednagar Blood Bank Collects blood and issues certificates for donors, health camp and HB detection camp is also organised on the same city.

14) State level Gangai - Babaji Mahotsav :

Gangai - Babaji Mahotsav is organised every year in commemoration of the parents of our patron and the founder President of our parent institution "Shetkari Shikshan Prasarak Mandal" Ashti, Dist. Beed, Honourable M.L.A. Mr. Bhimrao Dhonde.

The State level competitions, like, elocution competition, poetry reading competition, Lawani Dance competition etc. are organised by the college every year in this Mahotsav.

The main objective behind organisation of such competitions is to promote the talents of the emerging artists.

15) Gangai-Babaji Annul Magazine:

The Magazine with the writings of the students is published annually to promote the creative writing of the students. They write articles, poems, & write-ups in Marathi, Hindi & English. The Editorial Board scrutinizes the material. Students seek guidance from the concern teachers and reflect their hidden talents.

16) Student Council:

The Student Council is formed every year, with representative of all the classes. Throughout the year, it organises various programmes in college, like Flag hoisting, Birth & Death anniversaries of Great Leaders, University Foundation day etc.

The general secretary elected from among the council communicates with the authority regarding students common problem.

17) Cultural Committee:

The Committee promotes students to participate in extra curricular activites. Students

are sent to other colleges to participate in Debate, poetry recitation and Elocution Competitions. The committee offers special guidance for youth festival in the University. Every year the Students register in Youth Festival for various events.

18) Annual College Gathering:

Every year, Annual Gathering provides an opportunity to the students willing perform on the stage. Gathering is an attraction not only for the students but also for parents, Villagers, spectators and ex-students. Thousands of peope arrive in campus to witness the artists, dancers, singers and actors in students.

19) Alumni Association:

Alumni Association has been registered with the Charity Commissioner Beed. The meetings of the Alumni Association are held twice a year to discuss welfare programmes for the students. The suggestions and recommendations of the Alumni Association are noted down by CDC and the Management.

20) Research Promotion Committee:

The committee encourages the students and the staff to write research papers and send them to various National & International Journals for Publication. Minor Research Project Proposals are also founded to the University on the recommendation of the committee. The individual record is maintained by the committee.

21) Career Guidance & Placement Cell:

The Cell is active in the college. It guides students preparing for various competitive examinations. The coaching classes are also conducted to help students to qualify these exams. It also organises campus interviews of various camporiees & industries.

22) RTI:

Right to Information Act is observed in the college. Special officers are appointed for the same. Though few cases are reported, the officers are keen to work for that by maintaining all the records in soft copies as well as in hard copies.

23) Grievance Redressal Cell & Anti-Ragging Committee:

The Grievance Redressal Cell & Anti-Ragging Committee is active in the College. If there are any complaints from the students, they are resolved as early as possible. If senior students are found torturing juniors, they are counseled first and punished otherwise on the spot. The Discipline Committee checks that no outsider has entered in the compus.

24) Prevention of Sexual Harassment Committed:

Sexual Harassment at workplace has become a serious issue nowadays. If such cases happen the committee resolves them immediately. The college observes zero to Laurence policy regarding such cases. But the cases are comparatively rare.

To keep the environment of the compus pollution free, every Saturday is observed as No Vehicle Day. Automobiles are not brought in campus & we experience calm, quiet, sound free and pollution free day in a week.
