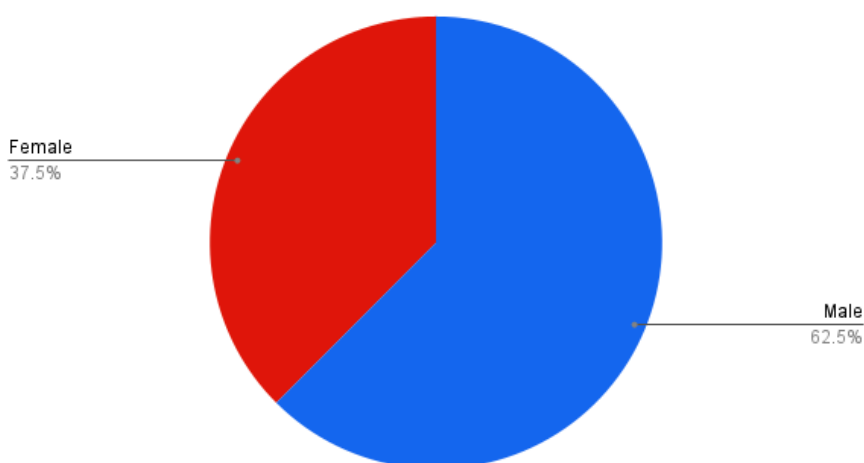
Student Satisfaction Survey for A.Y. 2020-21

Institution have been conducted a Student Satisfaction Survey regarding Teaching – Learning and Evaluation, which will help to upgrade the quality in higher education.

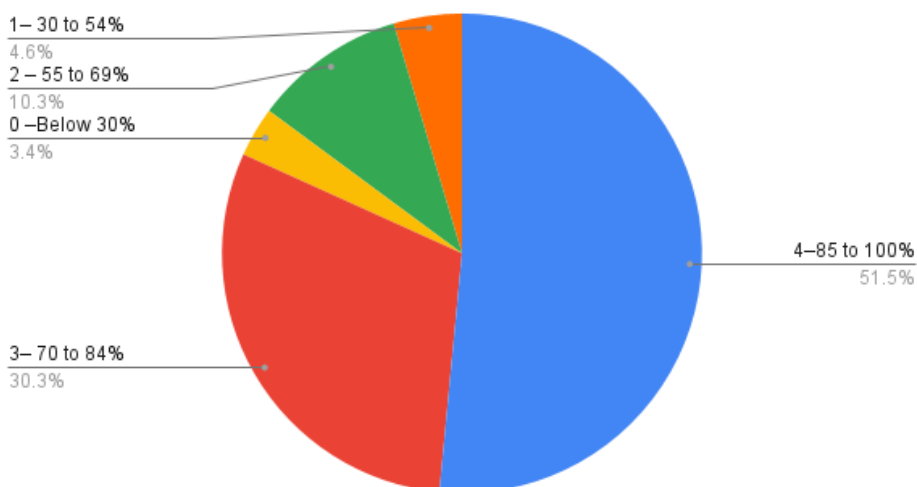
The student satisfaction survey was taken as per the guidelines given by NAAC.

Total Students Participated in Student Satisfaction Survey: 565

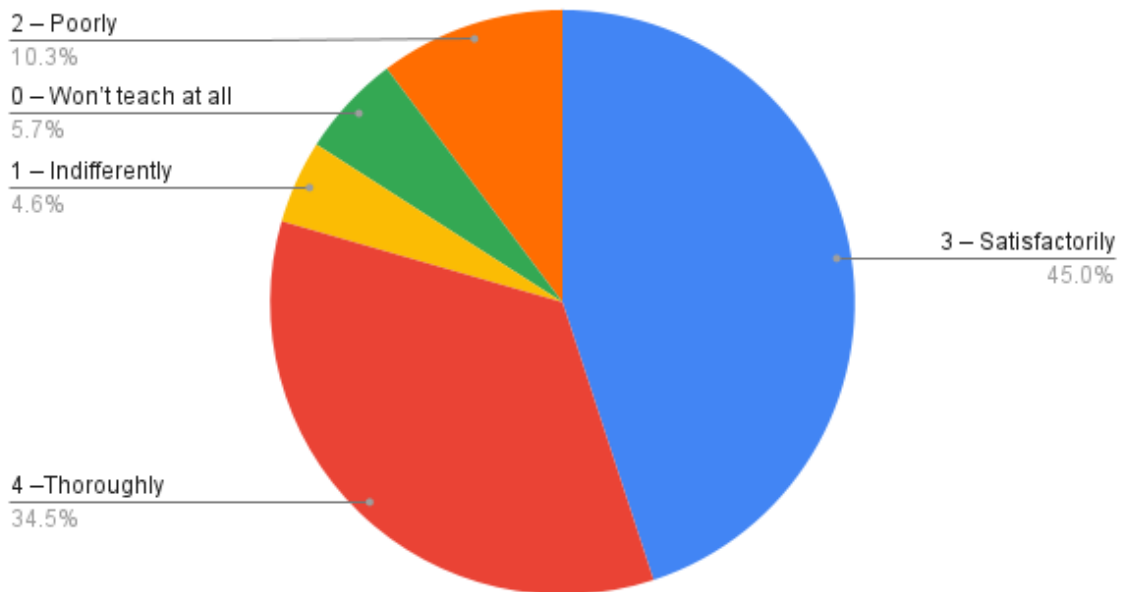

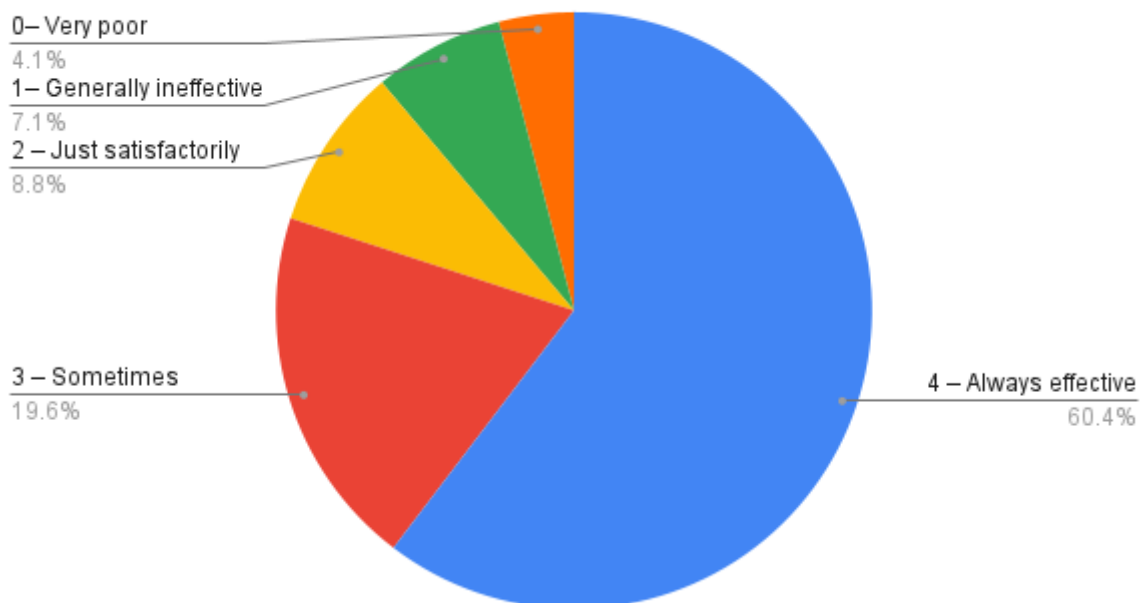

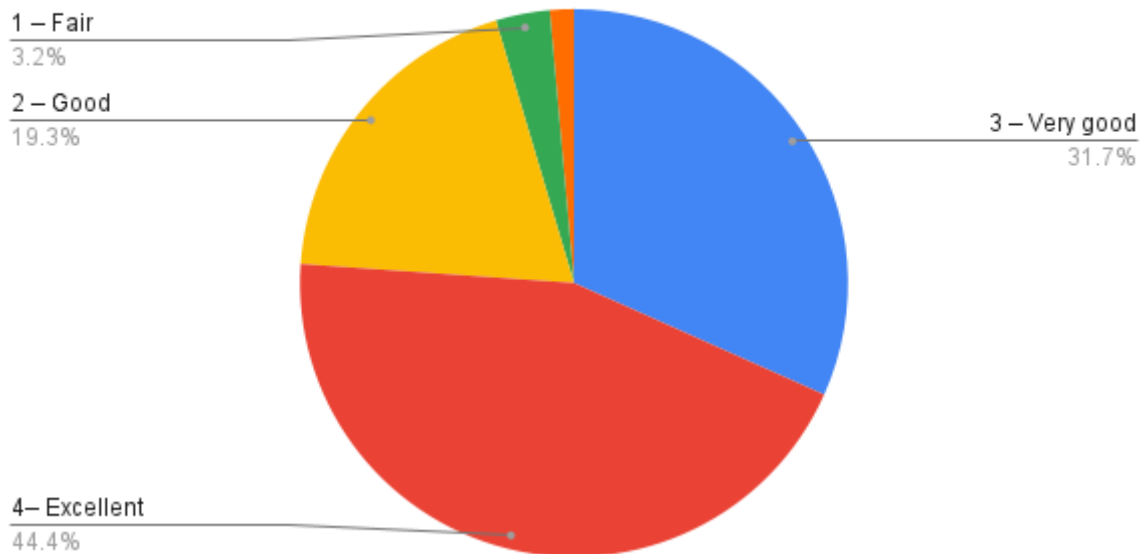
Count of 2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



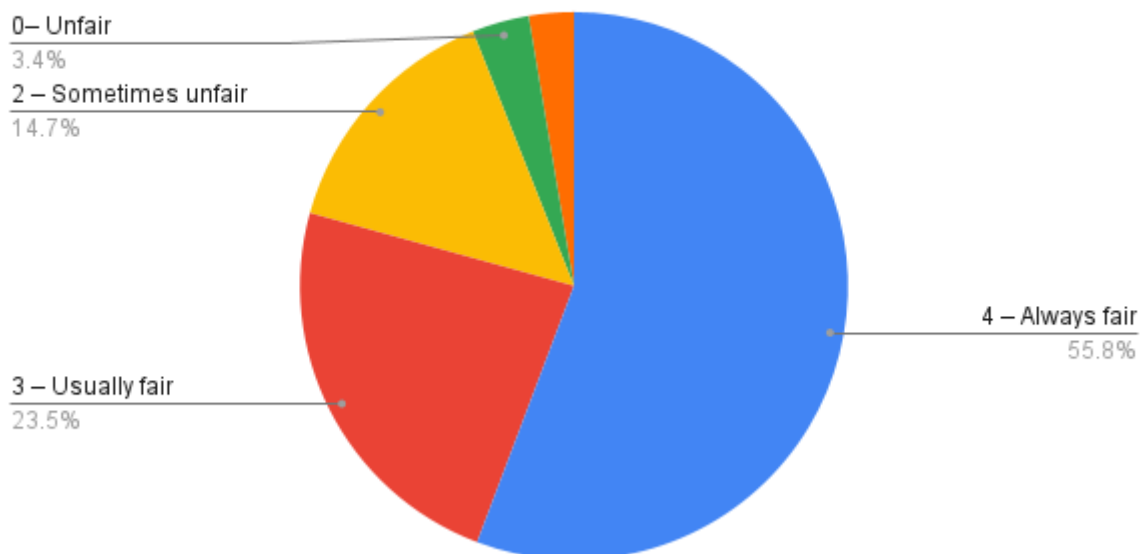
